

# King Mongkut's University of Technology Thonburi Admission Announcement KMUTT International Admission Project (Session 2) (Additional) Academic Year 2020

The King Mongkut's University of Technology Thonburi provides opportunity for students to continue their study in the Bachelor's degree under the KMUTT International Admission (Session 2) (Additional) Academic Year 2020. The admission procedures are as follows:-

<u>Application Dates:</u> 6<sup>th</sup> February – 23<sup>rd</sup> March 2020 (All programs except Landscape Architecture - (International Program))

19<sup>th</sup> March – 23<sup>rd</sup> March 2020 (only Landscape Architecture – (International Program))

#### General Qualifications:

- 1. Applicants must have completed or will be completing high school Mathayom 6 or equivalence before enrolling at KMUTT.
- 2. Applicants must have the minimum total credits of subject groups as required by the faculty.
- 3. Applicants must have the minimum test scores for GPAX, and GPA for the Science, Mathematics, and Foreign Languages Program as required by the faculty.
- 4. Applicants must not have any of the diseases which may be obstructed of their study.
- 5. Applicants must not have been expelled from any Educational Institution due to the negligence or misdemeanor.

### **Conditions Applicable:**

- 1. In case the eligible applicants have been accepted to study at KMUTT, they have to confirm their intention of studying at KMUTT with the Council of University President of Thailand (CUPT) within the stipulated deadline (For Thai Students).
- 2. If the eligible applicants have confirmed their intention of studying with CUPT but would like to make another application, they must waive their right as per the CUPT rules and regulations. Any application without proper waiving will be cancelled immediately although they passed the exams.
- 3. The list of eligible applicants who have confirmed their intention of studying in KMUTT will be announced to pay the confirmation fee according to the stipulated rate and timeframe by the University for Academic Year 1/2020. (Confirmation Fees include Educational Fee and Credit Fee for 15 credits or 13 credits for Bachelor of Science Program in Computer Science (English Program) or the programs as in package rate). The eligible applicants will be disqualified from admission in any late payment.
- 4. The confirmation fees once paid will not be refunded under any circumstances.

- 5. The eligible applicants are required to pass a medical test.
- 6. The eligible applicants can follow up the registration and the activity schedules of the university via website of the Registrar's Office at <a href="http://regis.kmutt.ac.th">http://regis.kmutt.ac.th</a>

## Required Documents for the examination day (Only those who are eligible to take the examination):

- 1. The application form with 1 inch photograph attached (photo must be taken within the last six months)
- 2. The copies of academic transcripts of the latest 5 semesters (for those who are studying Matthayom 6 or equivalence) or official academic transcripts (for those who graduated Matthayom 6 or equivalence).
- 3. Thai Identification Card or the copy of Passport in case of Foreigners.
- 4. Portfolio (if any)
- 5. The following documents are required only for the application to the School of Architecture and Design
  - 5.1 Copy of the English Proficiency Test (TOEFL/IELTS/CU-TEP/RMIT)
  - 5.2 Personal Statement of Motivation
    - Why have you decided to apply for the program? What are the reasons that you choose to study at SoA+D or KMUTT?
    - How the study can accommodate your future career plan or other things you would like to achieve after graduation?
  - 5.3 Two letters of recommendation from teachers/instructors of your previous Educational Institution.

#### Remark:

- Required documents No. 1 and 2 must be certified as true copies of the original.
