Round 4 KMUTT International Admissions (TGAT/TPAT Scores)
Faculty of Engineering Academic Year 2023

The King Mongkut's University of Technology Thonburi provides opportunity for students to continue their study in the Bachelor's degree under KMUTT International Admissions (TGAT/TPAT Scores) Faculty of Engineering Academic Year 2023. The admission procedures are as follows:-

Application Dates: 28th May – 9th June 2023

1. General Qualifications:

- 1.1 Applicants must have completed or will be completing high school – Mathayom 6 or equivalence before enrolling at KMUTT.
- 1.2 Applicants must have the minimum total credits of subject groups as required by the faculty.
- 1.3 Applicants must have the minimum test scores for GPAX, and GPA for the Science, Mathematics, and Foreign Languages Program as required by the faculty.
- 1.4 Applicants must not have any of the diseases which may be obstructed of their study.
- 1.5 Applicants must not have been expelled from any Educational Institution due to the negligence or misdemeanor.

2. Conditions Applicable:

- 2.1 In case the eligible applicants have been accepted to study at KMUTT, they have to confirm their intention of studying at KMUTT with the Thai University Central Admissions System (TCAS) within the stipulated deadline (For Thai Students).
- 2.2 If the eligible applicants have confirmed their intention of studying with TCAS but would like to make another application, they must waive their right as per the TCAS rules and regulations. Any application without proper waiving will be cancelled immediately although they passed the exams.
- 2.3 The list of eligible applicants who have confirmed their intention of studying in KMUTT will be announced to pay the confirmation fee according to the stipulated rate and timeframe by the University for Academic Year 1/ 2023 (Announcement of Confirmation Fee for Bachelor's Degree 2021). The eligible applicants will be disqualified from

admission in any late payment.

2.4 The confirmation fees once paid will not be refunded under any circumstances.

2.5 The eligible applicants are required to pass a medical test.

2.6 The eligible applicants can follow up the registration and the activity schedules of the university via website of the Registrar's Office at <http://regis.kmutt.ac.th>

3. Required Documents:

3.1.1 One photo of 1 inch (Taken within 6 months prior to application)

3.1.2 The copies of academic transcripts of the latest 6 semesters (for those who are studying Matthayom 6 or equivalence) or official academic transcripts (for those who graduated Matthayom 6 or equivalence).

3.1.3 Copy of the TGAT/TPAT Scores

3.1.4 Portfolio (if any)

4. Required Documents or the examination Date

4.1 To verify your identity on the day of the examination at KMUTT, please bring your ID card if you are a Thai citizen or a passport if you are a foreigner.

4.2 To verify your identity on the day of the online examination, please show your ID card (both front and back) if you are a Thai citizen, or your passport if you are a foreigner.

5 Vice President for Student and Learner Development shall oversee that all are proceeded in accordance with this announcement. In case there is any conflict or any circumstance out of this announcement, the Vice President for Student and Learner Development's order and consideration on that shall be deemed final.
