The King Mongkut's University of Technology Thonburi provides opportunity for students to continue their study in the Bachelor's degree under Direct Admission for Individual Based Program : IBP (Bachelor of Science Program in Science and Technology (Digital Design and Digital Technology)) (Session 2) Academic Year 2020. The admission procedures are as follows:-

<u>Application Dates:</u> 9th June – 17th June 2020

General Qualifications:

- 1. Applicants must have completed high school Mathayom 6 or equivalence before enrolling at KMUTT.
- 2. Applicants must have the minimum test scores for GPAX, and GPA for the Science, Mathematics, and Foreign Languages Program as required by the faculty.
- 3. Applicants must not have any of the diseases which may be obstructed of their study.
- 4. Applicants must not have been expelled from any Educational Institution due to the negligence or misdemeanor.

<u>Conditions Applicable:</u>

- 1. If the eligible applicants have confirmed their intention of studying with CUPT but would like to make another application, they must waive their right as per the CUPT rules and regulations. Any application without proper waiving will be cancelled immediately although they passed the exams.
- 2. Students who are being admitted must pay Education Fees and Tuition Fees as specified by the University Announcement.
- 3. The eligible applicants can follow up the registration and the activity schedules of the university via website of the Registrar's Office at http://regis.kmutt.ac.th

<u>Required Documents :</u>

- 1. The application form with 1 inch photograph attached (photo must be taken within the last six months)
- 2. The copies of official transcript of high school education or its equivalent.
- 3. An educational equivalent certificate issued by the Ministry of Education in Thailand for applicants who graduated from a high school abroad or an unaccredited international high school in Thailand.
- 4. The copies of standard test reports as required by the specific application type such as: Original score report of English proficiency (TOEFL / IELTS / TU-GET)
- 5. The copies of score report of Mathematics Standardized Test or Copies of score report of Physics Standardized.
- 6. Statement of purpose (only those who are eligible in Digital Technology)
- 7. Portfolio

<u>Remark</u>:

- Required documents No. 1 and 2 must be certified as true copies of the original.
